






## The Scholastic Book Fair is coming!

# YEAR 3 TO 6 CROSS COUNTRY RUN



This term the school's major sporting event is the year 3 to 6 Cross Country Run. Our school will be holding trials for each age group to determine the 10 students who will represent our school at the District Cross Country Run competition.

#### **House Sports/School Trials:**

The school trials with be held at Cardinia Recreation Reserve on Friday the 5<sup>th</sup> of May from 10.20 am to 12.20pm. The first 10 place getters for each age group and gender will form the team that will represent our school at the District competition.

Students need to be appropriately dressed for this running event, have a bottle full of water and dress in their house colours. We will be awarding a cross country house winner.

#### **District Competition:**

The district competition will be held on Tuesday the 16<sup>th</sup> of May at Cardinia Recreation Reserve. The students who have qualified to move to this round will receive a letter the week after the trials with all the information.

All students have filled out a permission form at the start of the year so do not require an additional one.



#### Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and Cardinia Primary School is excited to be participating.

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 8th September 2023.

All students at the school have now been registered, and we would like to see as many students as possible complete the challenge.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

To participate in the challenge, parents and/or students must login to the <u>PRC Application</u> and record the books that have been read. To do this, you will need your child's unique Username and Password. This will be sent home to you by your child's classroom teacher.

In addition, the PRC Application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs);
- a modern user-friendly interface;
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved; and the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review.


