

Science Fair 2023


Great news!! The Science Fair will be happening on Thursday August 24.



Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and Cardinia Primary School is excited to be participating.

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 8th September 2023.

All students at the school have now been registered, and we would like to see as many students as possible complete the challenge.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

To participate in the challenge, parents and/or students must login to the <u>PRC Application</u> and record the books that have been read. To do this, you will need your child's unique Username and Password. This will be sent home to you by your child's classroom teacher.

In addition, the PRC Application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs);
- a modern user-friendly interface;
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved; and the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review.
