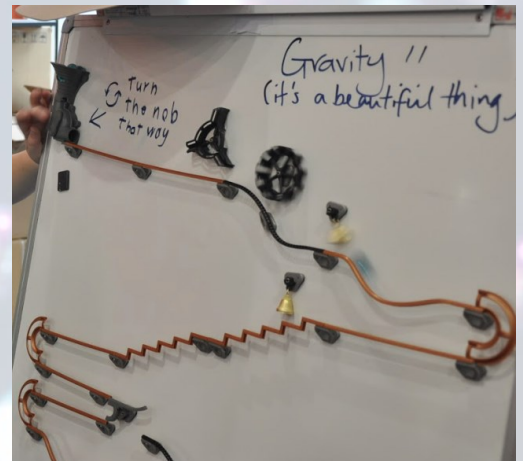
Science Fair 2023

Great news!! The Science Fair will be happening on **Thursday August 24.**

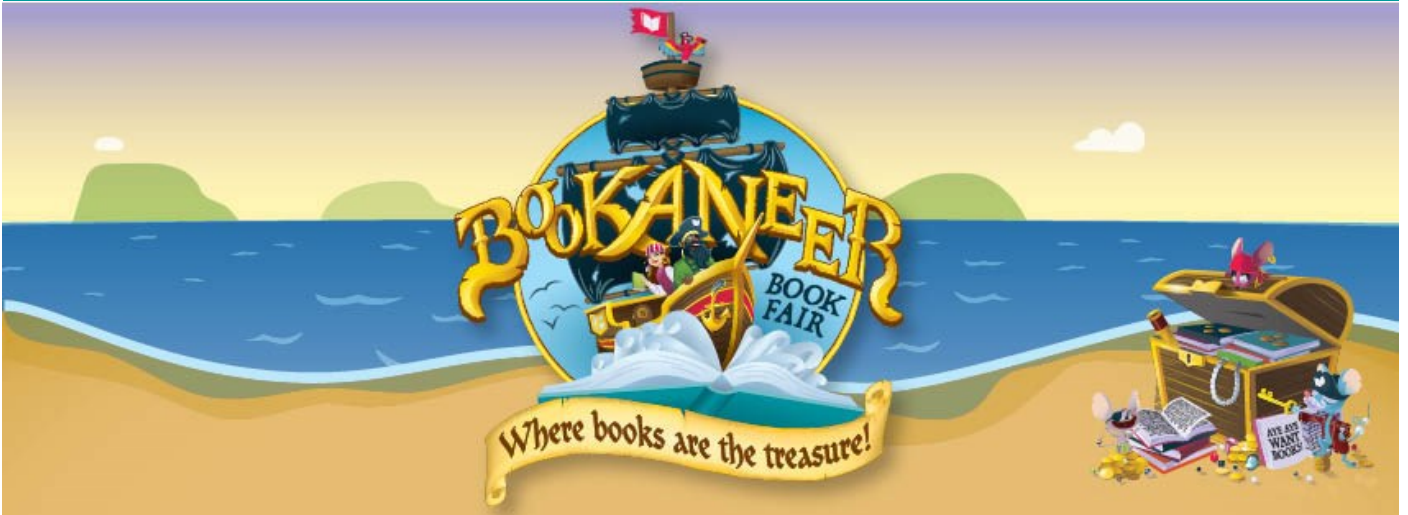
