# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

2nd September 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we continue in lockdown and remote learning, we are looking for ways to stay connected and to maintain a sense of wellbeing for our students, families and staff. Thank you for joining us at last week's Cardi Quiz; there was a true sense of connectedness there and lots of positive feedback.

I'd like to thank our teachers for continuing to come up with enthusiastic ways to keep our children engaged and learning online. This morning I attended a Principals' Conference. One of the presenters gave some examples of how teachers have described online teaching. Two that I particularly related to were "Like someone has taken away my spidey-senses" and "Online teaching is like teaching your class through a keyhole." 
## MEAL DEAL

The Meal Deal run by our Grade 6 students - Sausage in bread and a Cadbury Mini Roll - will go ahead when all students return to on-site learning.



The Pizza, Garlic Bread and a Lamington that was ordered previously for 16th July, will still go ahead when parents are allowed back on site.

My sister is as messy as a natural disaster. (Oliver)





