We got to sit inside police cars, see how speed cameras work and take an internal tour of the police station including the finger print scanner and holding cells. We got to experience what police work is like and it was a wonderful experience which the students thoroughly enjoyed. We now have lots of things to write about and lots of questions to ask in our next round of letters.
