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PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Hello Parents and Friends,

As we move into Term 4 we are planning our staffing and classroom structures for 2020. This year we have had 14 classes, many quite small. According to predicted numbers for 2020, Departmental guidelines will allow for us to have 12 classes. Our smallest numbers will be in the grades 3 to 6 area. For these reasons, next year we will have 3 learning groups of Grade 3 & 4 students, and 3 learning groups of Grade 5 & 6 students. The 3s and 4s will be in the Junior Learning Centre, the 5s and 6s will be in the BER.

Teachers are already quite excited about the possibilities this reorganisation will provide for your children's education. Our new Learning Communities will be ones where children and teachers work together as communities of learners, students will be in small groups to engage in collaborative investigation and discussion, constructing understandings, skills and knowledge at their level of development. These flexible learning communities will help develop each individual child's sense of belonging and connection to community.

We will have a parent information session at 3:45 on Monday 28th October where we will outline our plans and answer any questions you may have.

To facilitate our planning, please could you let us know if you are planning to leave Cardinia Primary next year. Likewise, if you know of anyone who is interested in enrolling at our school could you please encourage them to contact us? We have vacancies across most year levels.

Thanks to the parents who give up their time each week to provide "Meal Deals" for our students. Thank you also to those families who support this School Council fundraising by ordering the meals for their children's Friday lunch. If you are ordering a lunch for a Friday, please consider our "Meal Deal" of the week. So far this year our meals have raised \$4000 towards equipment for our students.

At assembly this week some of our students decided to try out the colours! Thanks Bella and Lily!!! Friday is going to be amazing – please come along to watch and support us. Only a third of our students have had online donations, and we've raised \$7000, that's probably about 4 computers. I'm hoping to increase this even further when our other students bring in the cash they have collected from their sponsors.

Hello everyone!

Our school has been selected to receive funding for a Breakfast Club in 2020 and we need some help!

The Victorian Government has committed funding of \$13.7 million to establish the School Breakfast Clubs Program. The School Breakfast Clubs Program provides a healthy breakfast for students who may otherwise arrive at school hungry.

To run the Breakfast Club we need parents, grandparents, or members of the community who are able to give some time in order to make this program run efficiently.

This program is not run by the teachers.

Helpers will set up the breakfast area, prepare and serve breakfasts and help clean up.

At this stage, the school is looking at Friday mornings somewhere between 8:15-9am. Unless we get enough volunteers to help however, we will have to forfeit the opportunity.

If you are able to give some time on a Friday morning (starting from Term One 2020) please put your name down on the list in the office and we will contact you before the end of term to discuss.

The department requires all volunteers to have a Working With Children Check.

Lions Eye Health Program



Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

Free vision screening is being offered by the Koo Wee Rup Lions Club in conjunction with the Lions Eye Health Program - Australia for all students at our school.

Over 80% of what children learn is processed through their eyes. Untreated eye conditions can affect a child's learning ability and self-esteem. It is estimated 1 in 5 children in Australia have undetected vision problems. Screening tests can help identify children who may require further eye review/testing.

Screening will be available on: **Friday November 15th 2019** for students in Foundation, Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 6 – all other Grades will be tested in February 2020.

Consent forms will be sent out on Thursday, please return the form by Friday November 1st if you would like your child to participate.


