PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

2nd November 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are all very excited for our Colour Run tomorrow. We have raised quite a lot of money, but there is still time for more if you have friends or families who might like to make a donation to our school. The children are very excited about the prizes they will be receiving! And quite a few are excited about seeing the Principal "slimed"!!

Tomorrow there will be an option for children to run without being covered in colour for those who are not keen on the idea. For children who love colour, the paint shows up extremely well on black and white.

We have decided to change our before and after school care providers. From next year we will be moving to DS Sports, the company who currently support our Sports in Schools program. DS Sports will offer sporting activities as well as non-sporting activities for our students in after school care, and will offer sport clinics after school for all children.

The classification for our school's fire danger rating has been changed. We are now required to close the school on days when the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) declares a "catastrophic" fire risk day for our local government area. This will usually occur the day before. With the weather predictions for this summer being very high risk for fire, it is likely that this will happen this year or early next year.

When there is a "catastrophic" fire warning you will receive an email and a text message from the school advising you that the school will be closed the following day. There will be signs on the gates at school advising that the school is closed. Before and after school care will not be operating. There will not be anyone on site.




