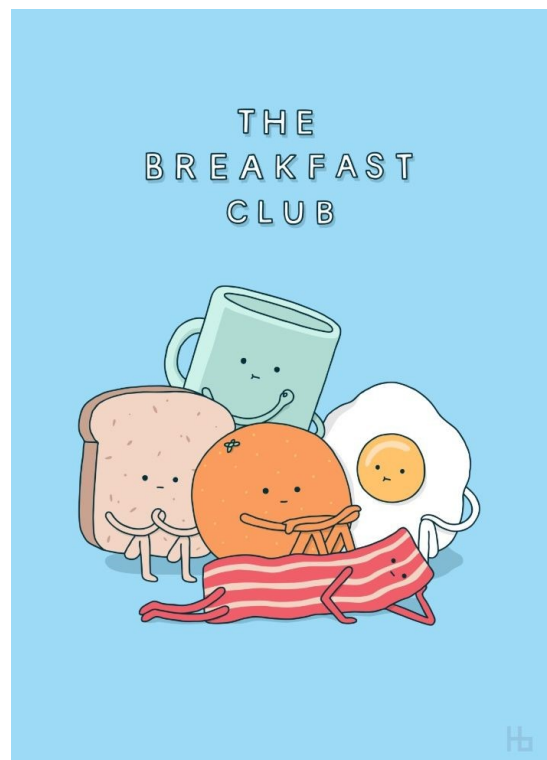

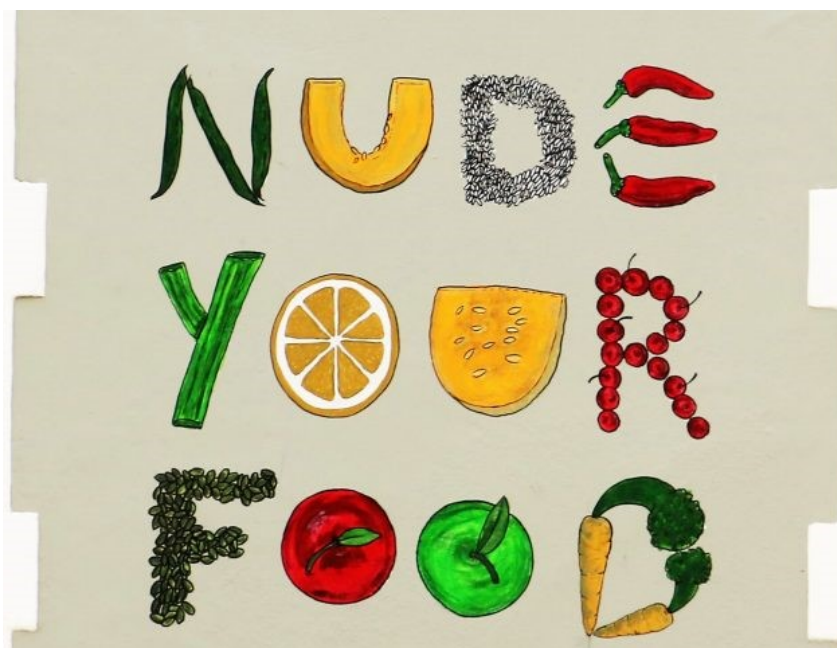
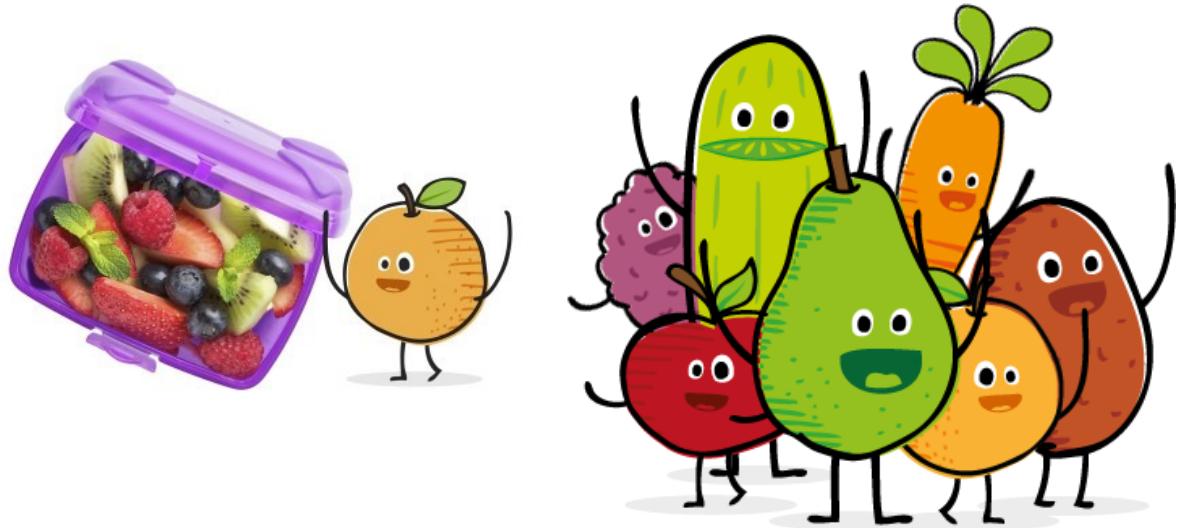


# Nude Food Day—UPDATE

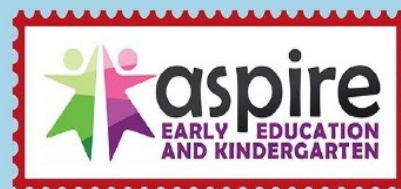

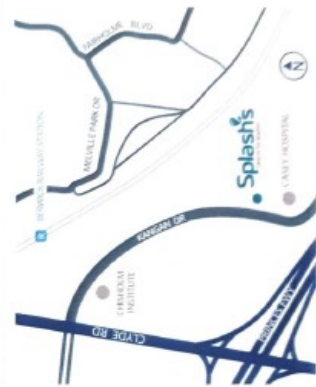
