## AROUND THE SCHOOL



### Foundation Teachers and Classes 2020

We welcome Karlie Italia into the Foundation teaching team in 2020. Karlie has taught Junior grades for several years at Cardinia Primary.

Next year Miss Karlie Italia and Miss Simone Van Parreren (Miss VP) will teach one class of Foundation (Foundation IVP), while Miss Emma Boyer will teach one class of Foundation (Foundation B).

Miss Italia and Miss VP will work together to provide continuity and stability for the children. They are both planning some travel during 2020, so Miss Italia will teach Semester 1 (Terms 1 and 2) and Miss VP will teach Semester 2 (Terms 3 and 4). Miss VP is an experienced Foundation teacher and we will ensure this transition is smooth for students. Miss VP will write to the children while she is travelling, and she has established relationships with many children this year, so she will be a familiar face to the children on her return.

Each class has 20 students at this stage, with an even split of boys and girls. Kindergarten groups have been kept together where possible, additional needs and Aide support considered, and sibling preferences for teachers accommodated where possible. There will be class lists displayed next Tuesday, so please take your child into their 2020 classroom on arrival. Miss Italia, Miss van Parreren and Miss Boyer will be waiting!

## Recycled Christmas Tree Project
