We thank her for all her hard work at Cardinia Primary School and look forward to seeing her again.

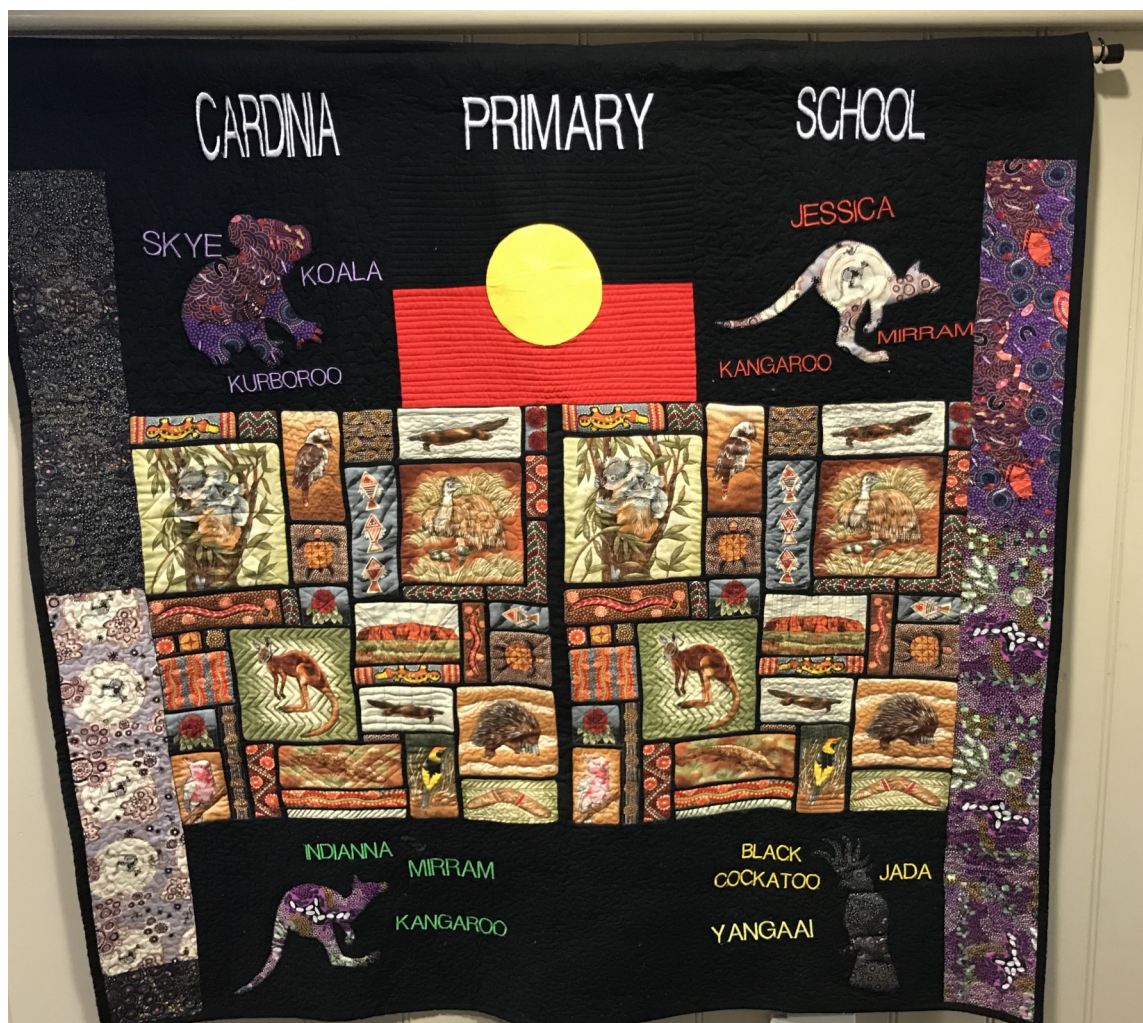




## WELLBEING COORDINATOR

# Yakkerboo 2020

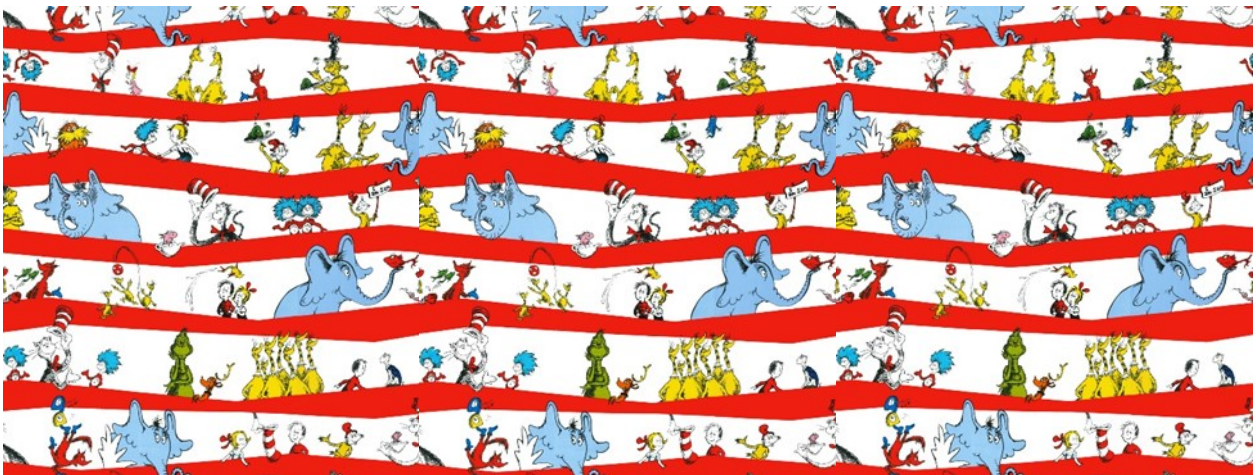


This year the Yakkerboo parade is on
